

- ◆ You must have a desire to serve the Lord
- ◆ As an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, you will assist the Priest by distributing the Eucharist and the Precious Blood to the Community during Mass
- ◆ You are required to take a four (4) hour training course by facilitators from the Diocese (Courses are given in English and Spanish)
- ◆ To renew your mandate every two years, you must attend one Diocesan-sponsored Day of Reflection
- ◆ You may choose to rove through all the Masses or choose to serve at just one Mass time
- ◆ You must meet with the Pastor prior to being accepted for this Ministry
- ◆ Please contact the Liturgical Coordinator, and they will submit your name to the Pastor
